TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 01 USA / CANADA DEPARTURE

Make your way to your gateway airport to board your flight to Tel Aviv, Israel. Enjoy in-flight meals and services. Overnight onboard the flight

DAY 02 TEL AVIV (-/-/D)

Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival at Ben Gurion International Airport, you will be met by our staff at the airport and transferred to your hotel. Overnight in Tel Aviv

DAY 03 CAESAREA – MUHRAKA – MEGIDDO – ACRE (B/-/D)

Depart Tel-Aviv and drive along the coastal plain to Caesarea, once the Roman capital of the region; visit the excavations of the ancient city, the Roman theatre, an aqueduct. Proceed to Muhraka, the site of confrontation between Elijah and the prophets of Baal; enjoy the spectacular view of the Jezreel valley and the lower Galilee. Continue to Megiddo, identified as the site of Armageddon; learn the impressive history of this battlefield as you visit the archaeological excavations including the well-preserved water supply system. Onto Acre to visit the remarkable underground Crusader City and crypt; walk through the Old City recognized by UNESCO as a world heritage site, the local market, and harbor. Overnight in hotel on the shore of the Sea of Galilee

DAY 04 TIBERIAS – CAPERNAUM – BANIAS (B/-/D)

After a short tour of Tiberias, enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee; visit the Yigal Alon center where the "Jesus' boat", an ancient fishing boat from the 1st century, is displayed. Continue to Capernaum to visit the

remains of the 2nd-century synagogue. Stop at Tabgha, the site of the Miracle of Fish and Loaves, and visit the Church of Multiplication with its 4th-century mosaic floor. Proceed to Mount of Beatitudes, the place where Jesus delivered the sermon on the mount. Drive to the Banias Springs and tour the Golan heights.

Overnight in hotel on the shore of the Sea of Galilee

DAY 05 CANA – NAZARETH – BEIT SHEAN – JERUSALEM (B/-/D)

Drive to Cana to visit the Wedding Church, where Jesus performed his first miracle turning water into wine. Continue to Nazareth to visit the Church of Annunciation, Joseph's workshop and Mary's well. Proceed to Yardenit, the baptismal site on the Jordan river; next, stop at Beit Shean to visit the newly excavated Roman city and amphitheater. Drive along the Jordan valley to Jerusalem.

Overnight in Jerusalem

DAY 06 JERUSALEM – OLD CITY (B/-/D)

Drive to Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of the city; visit the Church of All Nations, King David's Tomb and Room of Last Supper on Mt. Zion. Enter the Old City; walk through the Cardo, the ancient roman road; visit the Jewish and Christian quarters; view the Temple Mount; walk along the Via Dolorosa and the oriental Bazaar to visit the Church of Holy Sepulcher. Next, drive to the Garden Tomb and enjoy the beautiful gardens and peaceful ambiance

Overnight in Jerusalem

DAY 07 JERUSALEM – NEW CITY AND BETHLEHEM* (B/-/D)

Drive to Ein Karem to visit the Church of Visitation; proceed to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust. Visit Israel Museum, the Shrine

of the Book, where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and the miniature model of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period. Proceed to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus; visit Shepherds' field; walk through Manger Square to visit the remarkable Church of Nativity. Return to Jerusalem.

Overnight in Jerusalem

DAY 08 QUMRAN – MASADA – DEAD SEA – JERUSALEM (B/-/D)

Drive through the Judean hills to Qumran caves, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found; Continue along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, the last stronghold of the Jews after the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 A.D.; ascend Massada by cable car and tour the mountain fortress built by King Herod; visit the remains of the walls, water cistern and Herod's Palace; descend by cable car. Continue to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth; enjoy the opportunity to float in the unsinkable water and cover yourself with the mineral-rich mud, believed to have therapeutic effects.

Overnight in Jerusalem

DAY 09 BEN GURION DEPARTURE – USA / CANADA (B/-/-)

Today, after breakfast, you will be transferred back to Ben Gurion International Airport for your onward flight.

Day 9: Water Irrigation systems / Jojoba / Agricultural R&D / Solar-Thermal Power

After breakfast check out from your hotel. Drive to the South region of Israel to start our Agriculture visits.

Our first visit will include a fascinating presentation and tour about the global revolution in irrigation and fertilizer methods for modern agriculture. Continue for a visit to "Jojoba" fields. Learn about the Jojoba plant, how it is grown and how its oil is produced for the global cosmetics industry. Next discover the Secrets of Desert Agriculture in Israel. The tour proudly presents the astounding achievements of the Ramat Negev region in the development of flourishing agriculture, against all odds in extreme desert conditions, using brackish water in sandy ground.

Solar-Thermal Power Station

The tour presents the largest solar powered station in Israel. During the tour, the three types of technologies will be explained, but we will concentrate on the solar-thermal power station in Plot B, which creates electricity by solar-thermal hybrid tower technology more than 200 meters high.

Check in to your hotel in the Northern Negev Area.

Day 10: Asian medicinal vegetables and super- food / Desert wine

After breakfast, visit a boutique vegetable farm in the heart of the Negev desert which specializes in growing Asian medicinal vegetables and super-food. Thanks to the use of unique, innovative techniques adapted to the desert, the produce is considered the best in Israel. We will tour the assorted greenhouses, become familiar with various growing techniques and taste the exclusive produce, while listening to the family's special story.

Next visit a local winery, which is located in a hidden river valley and is built on the remains of an ancient agricultural settlement from the Byzantine period. The vineyard was carefully planted to preserve the ancient terraces and to utilize their previous irrigation system. Today, this desert farm produces wine from grapes

cultivated in the vineyards; Red grape varieties of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Barbara, and Pettit Verdot were planted alongside the white varieties of Chardonnay and Viognier etc.

Return to your hotel for dinner & overnight.

Day 11: BEN GURION DEPARTURE – USA / CANADA (B/-/-)

Today, after breakfast, you will be transferred back to Ben Gurion International Airport for your onward flight.
